

# **Campsite rules**

# § 1 Quiet hours

The campsite is for relaxation and rest. You must stick to the quiet hours from 1 pm to 3 pm and from 10 pm to 7 am. In this stretch of time you are not allowed to use any kind of vehicles (including bicycles).

## § 2 Walking pace & Roadways

- You may not go faster than walking pace on the entire site. This extends to bicycles! Driving slowly also keeps the dust down in the summer month.
- 2. Roadways must be kept free at all times and parking is only allowed in marked areas.

## § 3 Arrival & departure

- The pitch or the rental RV is available from 3 pm on. Should you arrive later than 5 pm, we ask you to contact us early. Otherwise we may rent your pitch to another guest.
- By the day of departure you have to free your pitch till 11 am. We may charge it separately if you depart later.

#### § 4 Dogs

Dogs must be kept on leash throughout the whole site. You are not allowed to take them onto the lawn or the sanitary facilities. You always have to clean up after them. So called attack-dogs are forbidden on the entire site.

# § 5 Safety distance

Between you're RV, camper or tent and the neighbors' you have to keep a fire prevention distance of three meters.

# § 6 Cleanliness & Garbage

1. You may only empty the slop or chemical toilet into the waste treatment area.

- 2. Do not leave trash unattended. Dispose of all trash bags in campsite garbage bins before leaving your site or returning for the evening.
- 3. Your pitch and all public areas have to be kept clean and out of trash all the time.

## § 7 Visitors

Your visitors may only enter the site if they are signed up at our reception.

## § 8 Working with fire or barbecue

- 1. It is forbidden to inflame fire all over the whole site.
- Barbecues may only be used with manufactured char. You are responsible for all damage you caused (e.g. sparks).
- 3. Barbecues and campfire hearths have to be kept under ward all the time.

#### § 9 Partys

- 1. You may not disturb your neighbors by holding a party.
- Please avoid loud singing and making noises; it's only allowed to play music in moderate volume.
- 3. From 9 pm on you may not party on or in front of your pitch.
- 4. Try to keep all disturbing noises as quiet as possible the whole day.

# § 10 Rental RVs

- Only use our rental RVs with pre contracted persons and treat all items with respect.
- 2. Please check your RV and the contained items when you arrive.



- You get a completition certificate and we ask you to check all items mentioned and give us a short feedback. If there are any lacks please inform us.
- For any lacks or the loss of items we ask you to refund expenses. You're also in charge for your fellow travellers.

## § 11 Use of electricity and water

- You are responsible for the condition of your electricity and water line from off the jack or sillcock.
- 2. If we ask you to, you have to show us a copy of the gas inspection.
- It is only allowed to store 11 kg gas and 2 liters of flammable liquids.

#### § 12 Fixed constructions

- 1. Every construction activity is forbidden at your pitch.
- Apart from your camper or RV you may only build up an awning or a pavilion if there is enough space available.
- 3. In the awning you may only lay out a carpet or artificial grass.
- 4. Fixed constructions are not allowed.

# § 13 Parent are responsible for their children

- Kids under the age of six are not allowed to use the sanitary facilities without their parents.
- 2. The bouncy castle may be used by kids up to the age of 14.
- 3. The use of the playground is at your own risk.

#### § 14 Householder's right

You may obey the rules made by our employees. The site manager is allowed to refuse the accommodation of people. If it's necessary the site manager may send you out of the campsite to restore calm and order.

# § 15 Campsite and weekend area regulation

Further orders are hold as mentioned in the national regulation for campsites and weekend areas of Schleswig-Holstein from the 13<sup>th</sup> of July 2010. This file may be inspected at our reception.
