

Camping regulations of *Bubulcus & Bolotas Camping*

1. Admission conditions

- The camping site is open all year. Exceptions will be previously announced and duly motivated.
- Access to the terrain and installation of tent, caravan or mobile home are subject to permission of the responsible person at the reception.
- By staying at the camping site the guest explicitly accepts and obeys the presented camping regulations.
- Any violation of the regulations can lead to removal off the terrain.
- In case of serious violations the direction of the camping site can call help of the police.

2. Formalities

- Anyone that wants to stay at the camping site has to report at the reception and present a proof of identity (ID card, passport or equivalent) and fill in the required forms.
- Guests are requested to report their departure one day in advance at the reception.

3. Installation

- Tents, caravans or mobile homes should be installed at the agreed location following the directions of the responsible person at the reception.
- Installation at a different than agreed location is not permitted.
- For every camping location a shade screen is available upon request.

4. Reception

- The reception is open every day from 9:00 to 11:00 and from 16:00 to 18:00.
- In case of urgent matters call the telephone number that is on display at information panel next to the entrance gate of the camping site.
- In the reception information is made available on the services of the camping site, tourist information, several descriptions of round trips, wild life in the environment and on sustainability.

5. Payment

- Payment should be done at the reception at the latest one day before departure.
- Tariffs are valid for the number of nights of the stay at the camping site.
- Tariffs are given at the website and at the information panel next to the entrance gate of the camping site.

6. Silence and tranquillity

- B&B Camping is a nature camping site where people can experience nature.
- Guests are requested to respect the tranquillity and refrain from any activity that causes loud noises or other hinder to their neighbours.
- From 23:00 to 8:00 complete silence is requested.
- At night, guests are requested to use only dim lights in order to enable good observation of stars.

7. Dogs and other pets

- At each camping place one dog is allowed.
- In the bungalows no dog or other pets are admitted.
- Dogs and other pets should always be on a lead and should have the obligatory vaccinations. Owners are responsible for cleaning faeces of their animals from the terrain.
- Dogs should never hinder other guests of the camping site.
- It is not allowed to leave dogs behind in caravans, mobile homes, tents or cars.

8. Visitors

- Visitors are allowed from 9:00 till 20:00.
- Visitors should report at the reception.
- Visitors should obey the presented camping regulations.
- Cars of visitors should be parked at the parking at the north end of the terrain.

9. Parking and traffic

- At the camping site the maximum driving speed is 10 km/h.
- No traffic is allowed between 22:00 and 8:00.
- Cars are allowed at the terrain at arrival and departure and for bringing goods (shopping) to the camping places. There are no parking places close to the camping locations.
- Clients should park their vehicles at the parking at the north end of the terrain.
- It is forbidden to hinder traffic or installation of new guests.

10. Bungalow

- The camping site has one fully equipped bungalow.
- The maximum capacity of the bungalow is 4 adults, or 2 adults plus 3 children with a maximum age of 16 years.
- Upon handing over the key, a form will be provided indicating a) the conditions of the stay with respect to the equipment, materials and general conditions of the building; b) cleaning times and periodicity of changing bed sheets and towels by the

direction of the camping site.

- Smoking is not permitted in the bungalow.
- Reservations are only accepted after payment of 50% of the tariff of the stay.
- If a guest does not show up on the first day of the reserved period of stay, the reservation is considered to be annulled.
- Guest have the right to annul a reservation with return of the down payment until 15 days prior to the first day of the reserved stay.
- Guests are responsible for maintaining the bungalow, the furniture, equipment and materials in good order and clean.

11. Character of the camping site

- B&B Camping is a nature camping site. Guests should refrain of actions that can compromise the order, hygiene or the character of the camping site. Parents are responsible for the actions of their children.
- It is forbidden to leave any litter on the soil. This includes cigarette filters.
- It is forbidden to put anything in the soil (except tent pins).
- Waste should be deposited in the available containers.
- There are green containers for glass, blue containers for (dry) paper and carton and grey containers for residual waste.
- If the containers are full, please inform the responsible person at the reception.
- Please take care not to leave any food behind. We do not want to attract foxes and other animals.
- The sanitary building is cleaned twice per day. Please help us to keep it clean by leaving the toilets behind in clean condition, cleaning the kitchen top after doing the dishes and cleaning the laundry tank after use.
- Damages to the installations, trees, shrubs, fences or anything else are the liability and will have to be paid for by the person that has caused it or in case of children by their parents.
- The camping location has to be left behind in the same condition as it was before arrival.

12. Safety

- The entrance gate of the camping site is closed from 22:00 till 8:00.
- Guests are responsible for their own goods. The direction of the camping site is not responsible for theft, loss or damage of the properties of the guests.
- Presence of suspect persons should be immediately reported at the reception or when the reception is closed reported to the telephone number given at the information panel next to the entrance gate of the camping site.
- Open fire and fire in baskets or bowls are strictly forbidden.
- Please take extreme care when smoking, especially make sure that cigarette tips are well put off.
- Smoking is not allowed in the bungalows, nor in any other building.
- Barbecuing is allowed under strict conditions. The barbecue should always be under permanent supervision of an adult. Do not leave the barbecue until the fire is completely off. In periods of extreme dryness or in very windy periods the direction of the camping site can temporarily forbid the use of barbecues. The direction of the camping site has one barbecue available for the guests.
- Cooking equipment should be in good condition and should not be left burning without supervision.
- In case of fire report immediately at the reception.
- Sand buckets (S.I.) and fire extinguishers are available for everyone. Upon arrival, please check the location of the nearest fire extinguisher.
- A first aid emergency kit is available at the reception.

13. Direction of the camping site

- The direction is responsible for the good order of the camping site. The direction has the duty to take measures when the regulations are seriously violated and if needed to remove persons that disturb the order from the terrain.
- There is a book of complaints at the reception.
- There is also a book of compliments at the reception for those who wish to express their appreciation.
- Suggestions for improvement are always welcome.

14. Arrival and departure

- Arrival between 11:00 and 21:00. If the reception is closed at the time of arrival, put up your tent, caravan or mobile home at an available camping location and report to the reception at the first possible time.
- Departure between 8:00 and 11:00.
- The camping location should be cleared latest at 11:00. If the place is cleared at a later time a full extra day will be charged.
